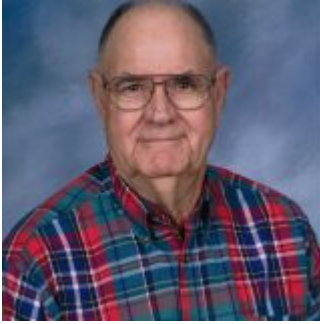


Alex Samuel Andrews
