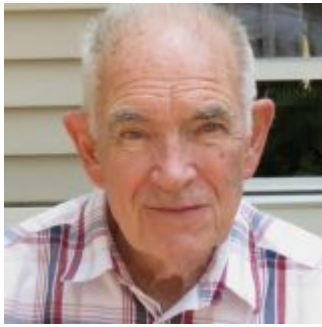


William “Bill” Lynn Campbell
