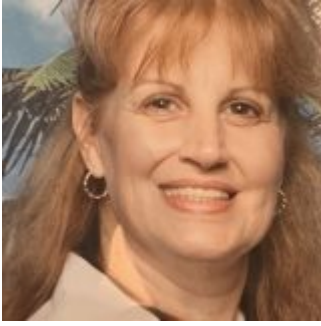


Pamela Ann Toups
