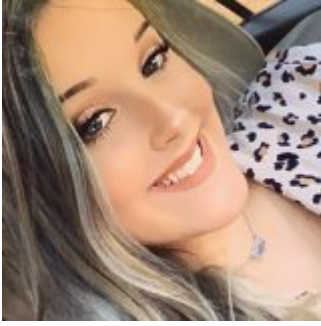


Ava Rose Butcher
