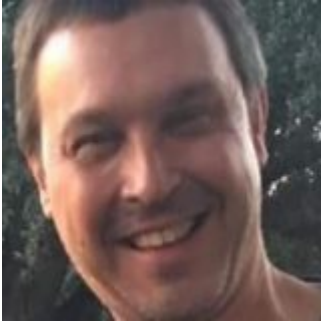


Darren Sean Didier
