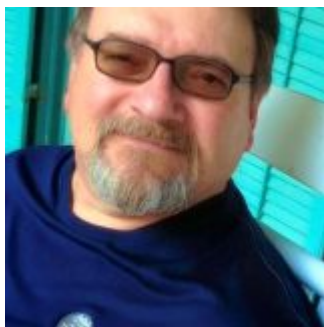


Mark James Blanchard
