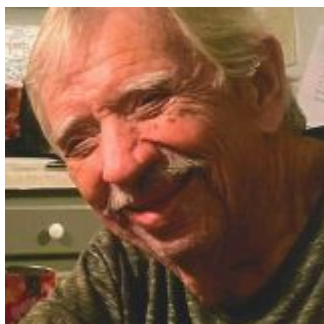


Michael Joseph Fesgen
