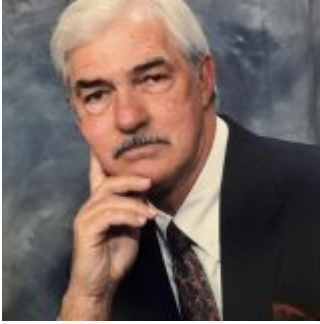


Ezra Nelson Albin

He loved spending time with his family, hunting, History, and chopping his own firewood for the fires he built in his home even in his final days.
