Glenn Ray Wunstel, 72, a resident of Bayou Pigeon, LA since 1981, was taken home on Monday, Feb. 28, 2022 after battling cancer. He was born July 16, 1949 in Baton Rouge, LA. Known to older friends as "Prophet", Glenn was a dedicated motorcyclist who transversed our nation many times, making it to Alaska twice.
