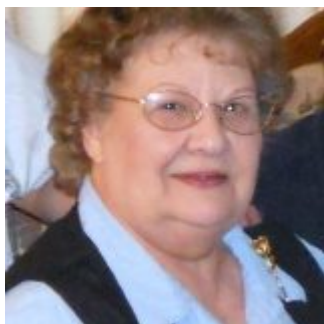


# Nancy Ellen Stephenson Brown
