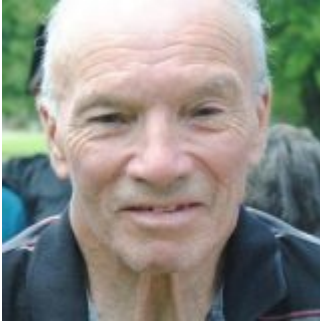


Robert “Bobby” Neal McLain, Jr.
