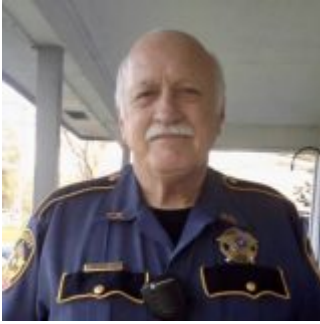


Malcolm Roger “Mac” Watts
