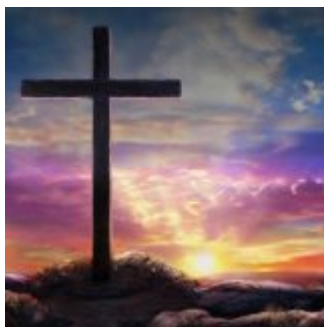


William “Mike” Elmore
