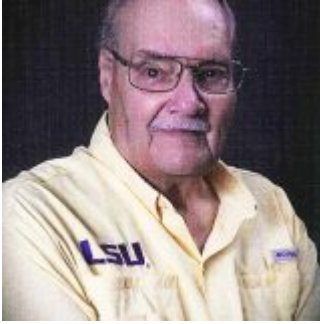


# Lester P. Kohler
