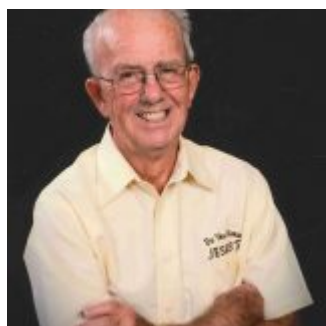


Tommy G. Jones, Sr.
