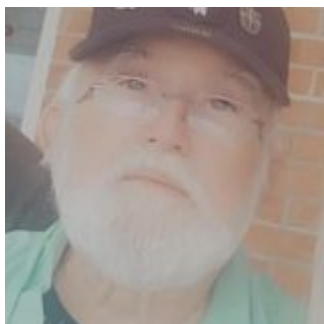


Manfred “Gene” Ungaro
