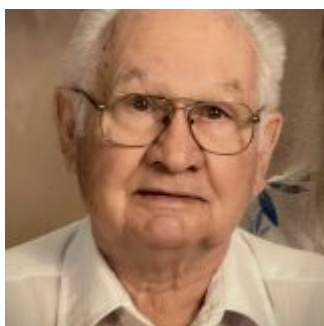


# Freddie Joseph Fossier, jr.
