They moved from Orlando to Tallahassee in 1964 with 5 children in tow then to Madison Ms. in 1976. In 1995 they moved back “home” to Florida after daddy retired and built a home on the Wakulla river. They were married for 51 1/2 years until daddy died in November 2005. Florence stayed in Florida by herself until 2007 when she moved to Denham Springs, La. to be close to family. She was a devout Catholic and a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Denham Springs.
