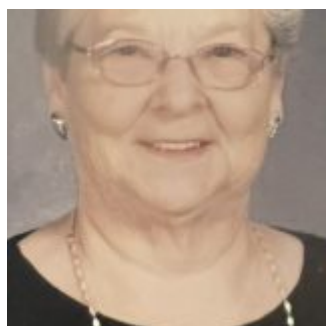


Mary Inez Freeman Brown
