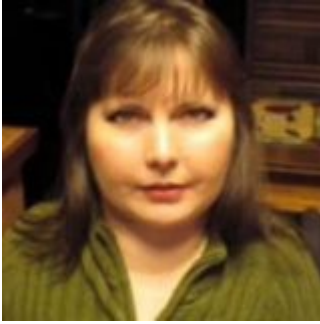


Donna Christine Bell
