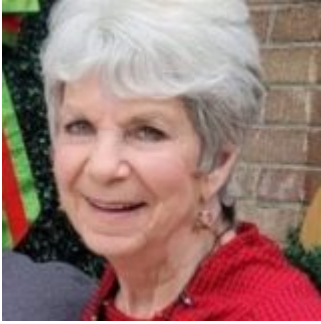


# Elaine Judith Glover Borskey
