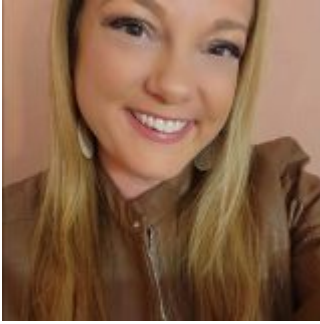


# Heidi Christine Gilbreath
