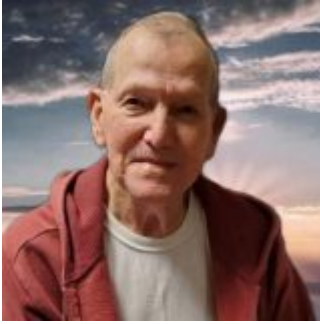


# James Farley Baroni, Sr.
