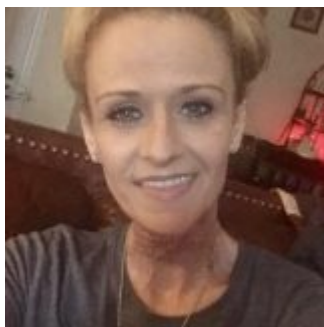


Julie Brisco Butters
