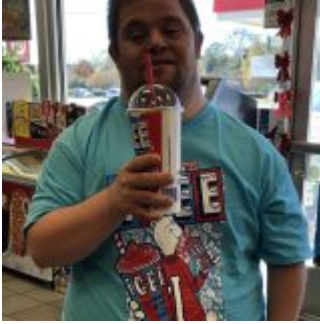


Kenneth “100” Raymond Vice
