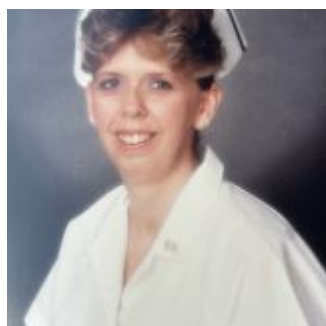


Karen June Estes
