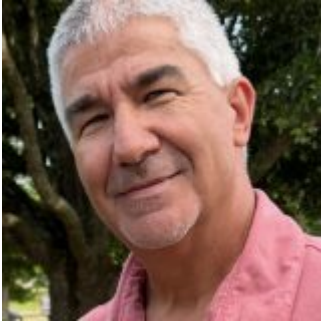


Billy Ralph Gibson Jr



Billy Ralph Gibson Jr., 61, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, Dec. 15, 2024.
