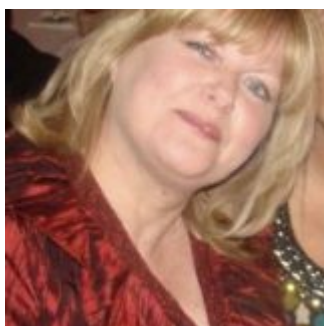


Ann Booth
