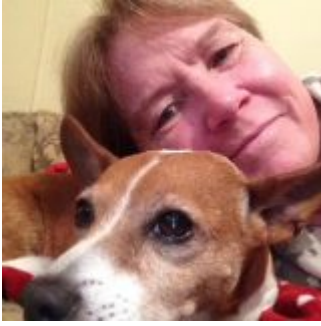


# Kristy Lea Smith
