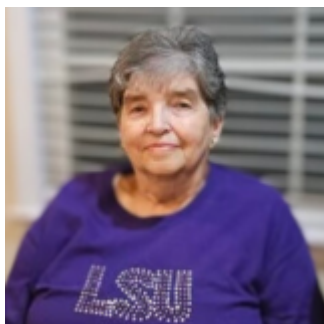


Cynthia Ann Breeden Rogers
