Albert S. Hulett, of Hammond, Louisiana died on Saturday, March 15, 2025. He was born in Hattiesburg, MS and was a 1966 graduate of Hattiesburg High School. He earned a degree in Business Administration from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX in 1970, and later earned a degree in Architecture from Tulane University in New Orleans, LA in 1986. Al spent several years as a Business Manager for an architectural firm in Texas, and then spent seventeen years as President of Roseland Park Cemetery and Beverly Memorial Co. in Hattiesburg, MS, businesses owned by the Hulett family. After the business was sold in 1995, he was employed by several architectural firms, including Sasaki Associates in Boston, MA, and eventually retired from Sizeler Thompson Brown Architects in New Orleans, LA in 2012.

Al is survived by his son, David Carruth Hulett, of Las Vegas, NV; daughter and son-in-law, Kennon Beverly Hulett and Casey Krugman of Jersey City, NJ; grandson, Brandon Carruth Hulett, of Las Vegas, NV; several cousins; and his long-time partner, Eric Johnson, of Hammond, LA.
