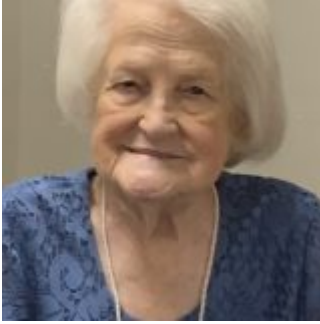


Edna Zemly Sibley Covington
