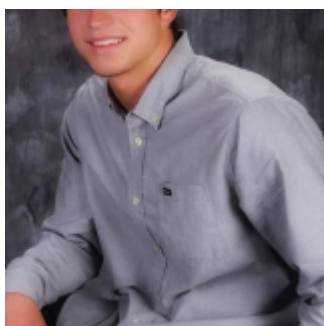


Traynor Bratten Freeman
