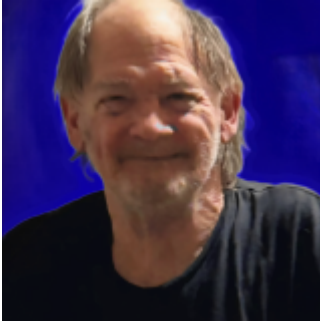


# Samuel “Dale” McCarter
