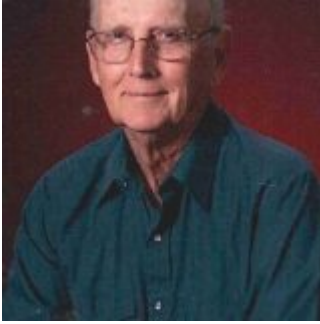


# Charles O. Miller
